A Great Opportunity!

Learning an instrument can be fun and is a great way for pupils to acquire skills such as self discipline and commitment. It can also help to improve self esteem and self confidence.

Most instruments are taught in small groups and once they progress pupils can join one of many area and county ensembles and orchestras, so learning can also be a great way to make new friends.

Our teachers are highly trained and experienced musicians, and support schools across the county.

Each lesson usually lasts for 20 minutes with 34 lessons provided in an academic year.

Music Teachers have been asked to teach pupils in groups where possible as this helps to keep costs as low as possible. However, if this is not possible for 'educational reasons' solo lessons may continue for a period at the school's discretion.

The price for lessons is reviewed each term, and will be **£10 for a 20 minute lesson**. Where teachers agree a different time schedule a pro rata charge will be applied.

Invoices will be issued at the start of each term with payment due within **21 days** from receipt of invoice.

If a teacher misses a lesson for any reason a replacement lesson will be provided as soon as possible. It will not be possible to make a refund where the pupil misses a lesson.

If your child wishes to stop having tuition half a term's notice is required by the Music Service, which must be given to the school in writing. Payment will still be due for these lessons even if the student does not attend. This will provide an opportunity for the tutor to revise groups if necessary.
