

The pupils in receipt of 'Catch-up Premium' benefitted from a range of interventions to support them in closing gaps in their reading and/or spelling and making some exceptional levels of progress. The average amount of progress made in reading over the course of 12 months for these students was 34 months. This has resulted in 50% of these students now having a reading age which is at or above their chronological age. The average amount of progress made in their spelling over the course of 12 months was 16 months.
