Dear Parent/Guardian,

We are writing to you with reference to the preference of language that your child would like to apply to continue to study until year 11. Current year 8 pupils have experienced lessons in both French and Spanish and pupils are now required to apply to study one of the two languages. The language allocated will be studied for three hours a week throughout the remainder of years 8, 9, 10 and 11, resulting in a GCSE qualification.

It is recommended that the preference of language is carefully considered, while noting that both French and Spanish are highly valued as languages in Europe and worldwide. Please note that French **and** Spanish classes will run in both A and B teaching groups. An information evening about the year 8 'options process' is being held on **Tuesday 27th November**, a separate letter has been sent to you via e-mail with details.

Please complete the form below and return to the **school office** no later than **Friday 30th November 2018**. If we do not receive a completed slip from a pupil, they will be allocated a language to study by the Department.

We would at this stage like to emphasise that the school reserves the right to make the final decision regarding the language a child is allocated based on effort, attitude and ability. Parents/pupils can express an interest in a language, but may not ultimately be successful.
