# Attendance

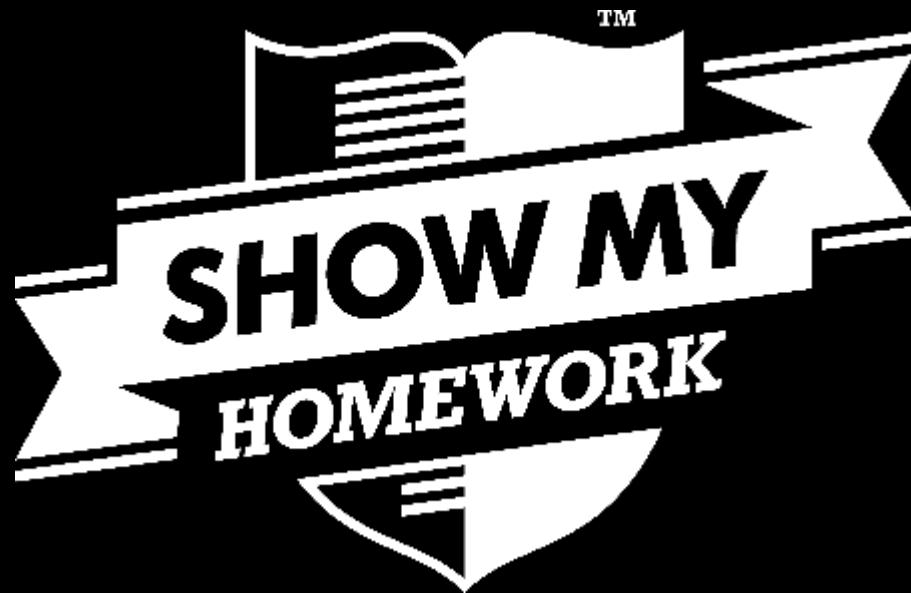
- \* **Link between good attendance and high achievement is well proven**
- \* **95% Attendance = Half a day missed every two weeks**
- \* **95% Attendance = Two weeks missed each year**
- \* **95% = Almost a whole term missed over 5 years**
- \* **Topics only covered once!**



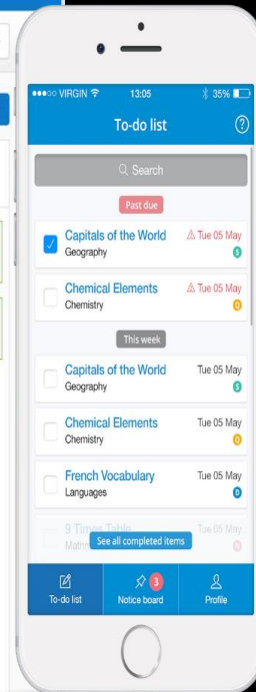
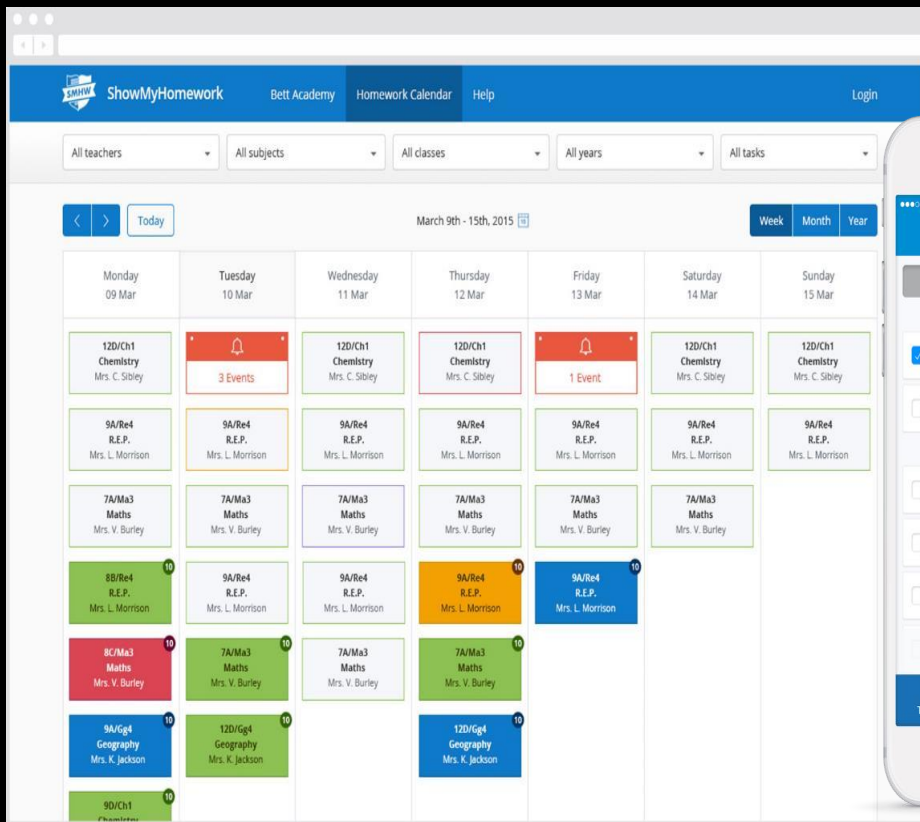

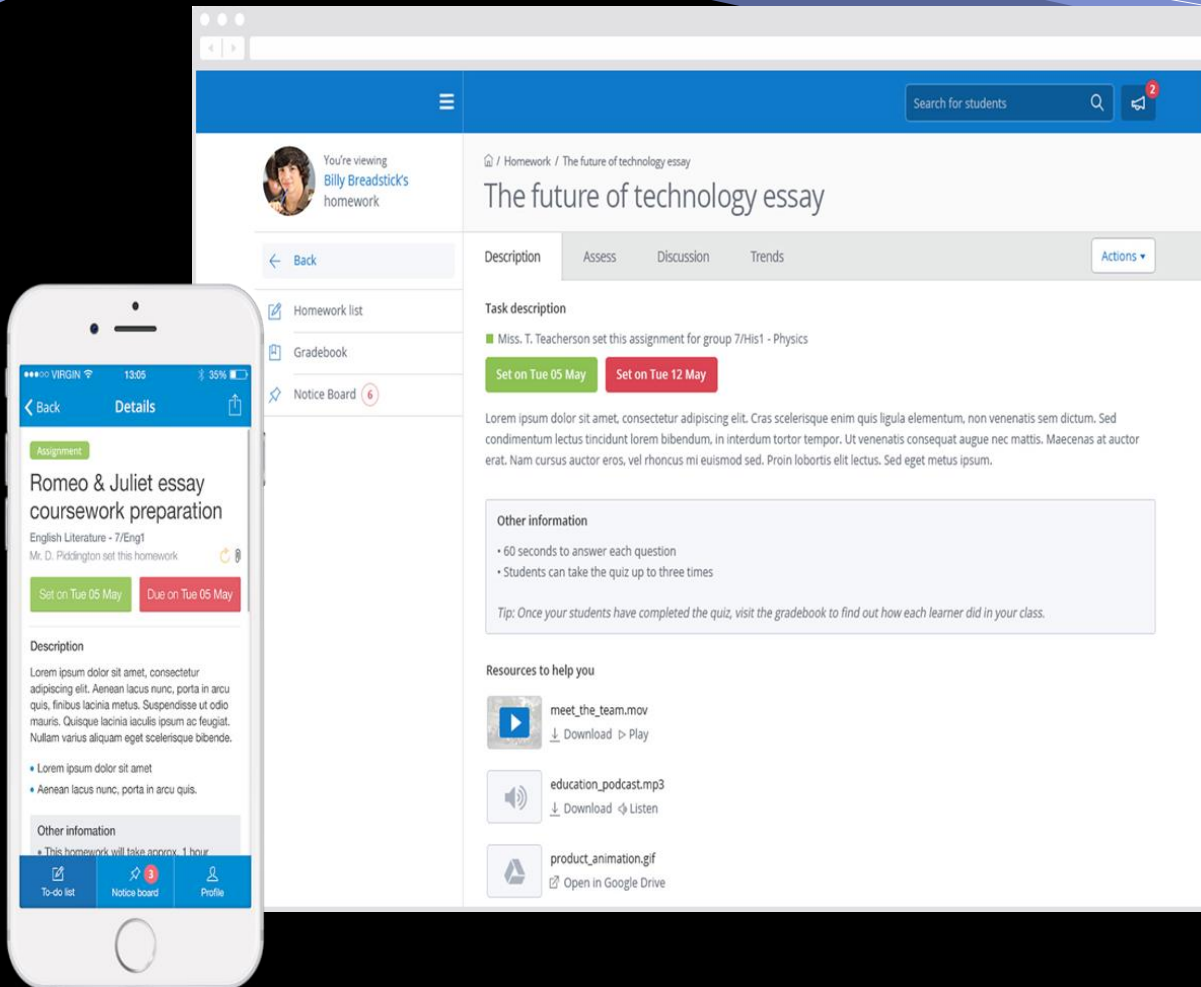

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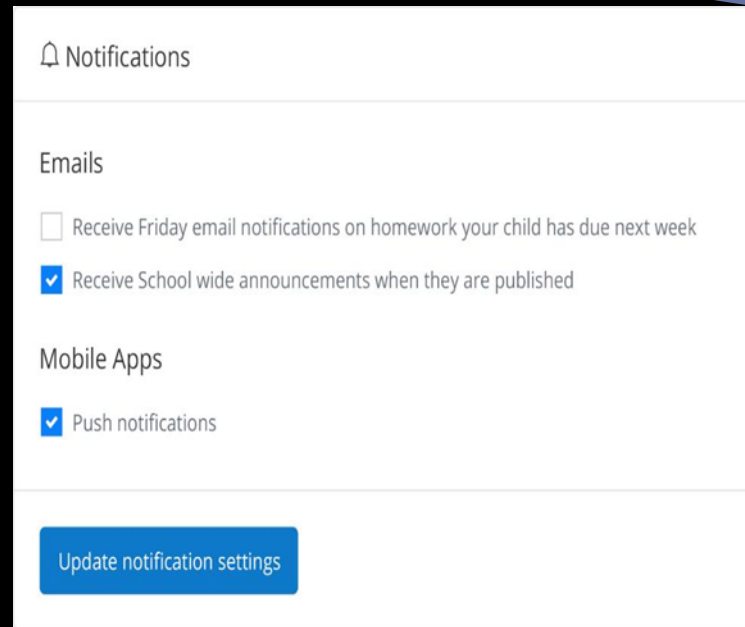
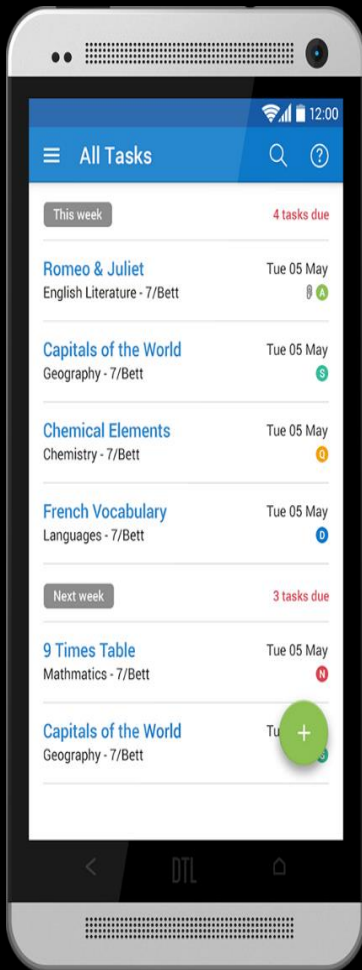
