THE CORBET COLOUR RUN / WALK - THURSDAY 2nd APRIL, 3.45 – 4.30PM

The School Sports Council (students in Years 9 -11) with the PE Department are very excited to be organising a Colour Run / Walk Charity event at school for all pupils on:

- Thursday 2nd April
- School Field
- 3.45pm start, 4.30pm finish

All pupils are invited to participate for fun and to raise money for Severn Hospice and the PE extra-curricular programme.

The entry fee is £6 per pupil which includes the cost of pouches of coloured powder (pupils will be given 1 at the start). Runners need to supply their own white t-shirt. Proceeds will be split with 50% donated to Severn Hospice and 50% PE Department extracurricular programme.

The nature of a colour run/walk is that the participants all wear white t-shirts and throw coloured powder into the air over all the participants at the start, creating a colour cloud. All the participants get covered in powder. As they run there will be designated areas where additional colours are thrown at the participants by designated throwers. All participants are advised to wear old clothes and trainers for the event as the powders may stain clothing.

After the run/walk an area will be designated to "shake off" the loose powder but we advise each participant has a large sheet or blanket to wrap themselves in before sitting in a car to go home. At the end pupils will not be allowed back into the school buildings and will need to make their way around school to go home. The school will not take any responsibility for damage to personal clothing or equipment including phones.

The colour powder used at this event is all certified non-toxic and non – irritant to skin (conforms to EN- 71 - 3 standard). The bright coloured powder is produced using non – toxic pigments. All participants need to be aware that the powder may come into contact with skin and eyes and there is a risk of inhalation. All participants take part at their own risks. Participants may want to wear goggles or dust masks/scarves.


