Communication:

Following on from recent correspondence, I write to advise you that we will move to a weekly update to parents, issued on Wednesday. Please do continue to look out for e-mail updates throughout the week from other members of staff.

Children in our care:

By prior arrangement, only children of critical key workers who cannot be safely provided for at home by one or other parent can come into school.
