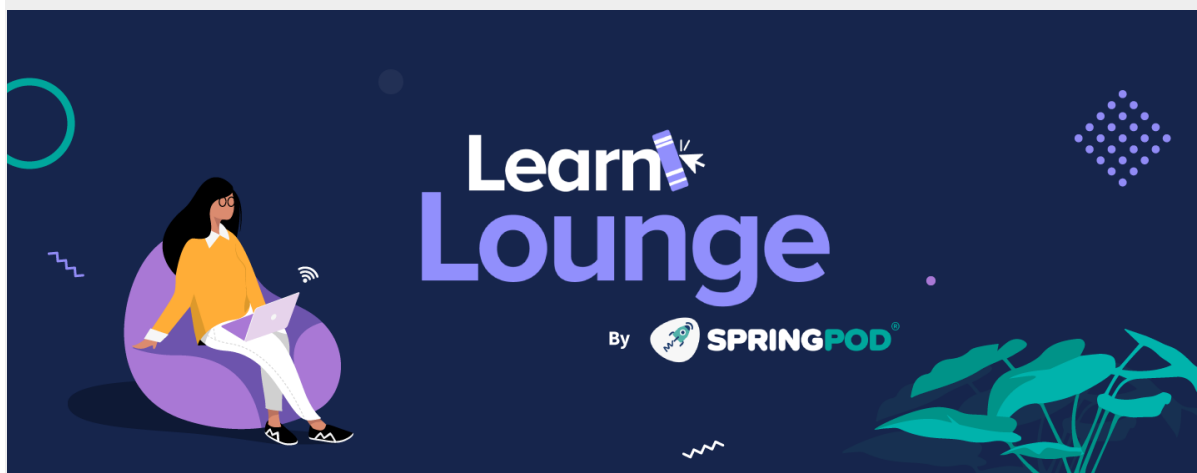

Our service is quick and easy to implement, and means that the routine of your school curriculum can continue with the minimum of disruption during these troubling

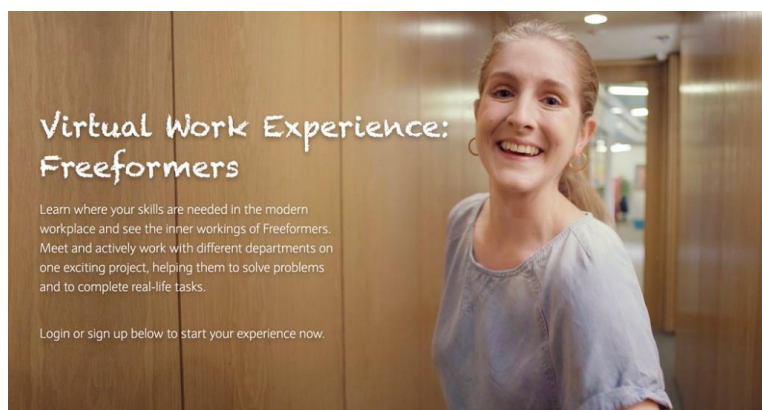
It enables teachers to set online lessons for specific year groups in a matter of seconds, and across different subjects. We can now offer this additional free service to all schools across the UK.
