Pupils have free access to the online 'Research Skills' programme being offered by EtonX. To gain access to this course please follow the instructions below:

How to sign up to your EtonX course:

- 1. Visit the EtonX website and click Sign up.
- 2. Choose Sign up with Access Code.
- 3. Enter your Access Code (M69WZBKY)
- 4. Follow the on-screen instructions. Please sign up with your **school email address** (alternatively you can a personal email address).
- 5. Congratulations! You can now get started on your course.

Once you have created your account, you can always log in at https://learn.etonx.com/login to finish your registration and access your course. If you face any issues during sign up or have any questions, please contact etonxoffer@etoncollege.org.uk.

The course will be available until 31st July and upon completion pupils will receive a certificate.
