# LIBRARY CLICK-AND-DROP SERVICE

Our School Library is currently operating as a Classroom for Year 9 ONLY but **everyone still has access to our Library books**. We have an extensive range of fiction, non-fiction and reference titles and we are continuing to loan out Library books using our **Click-and-Drop service**.

## Loans, a recap:

Each pupil has their **own library account** and may **borrow up to three books at a time** (unlimited loans for the Christmas holiday).

The **loan period for Library books is three weeks** (**books borrowed before Christmas will be due back on 8th January 2021**).

Library books **must be returned through the letterbox under our Library noticeboard** (next door to student support services).

In these unprecedented times, **finest will be waived** on overdue books, providing they are returned in the condition in which they were borrowed.

Mrs Brett will deliver Library books to Tutor rooms during Morning registration.

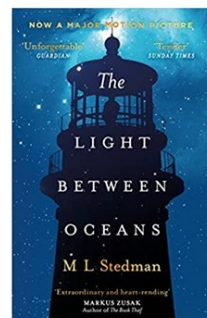
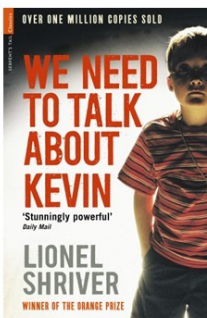
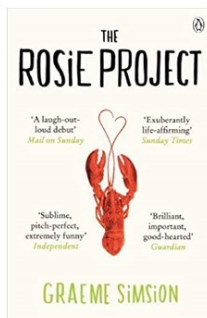
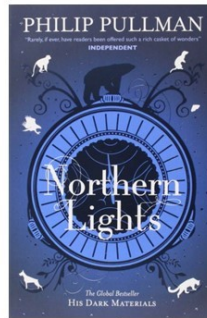
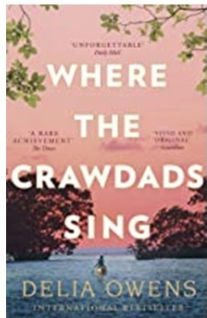
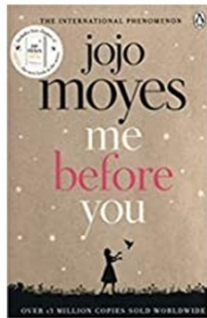
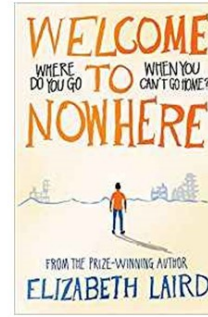
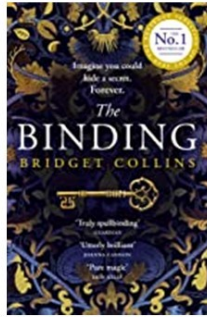
Each paper bag will be labelled with:

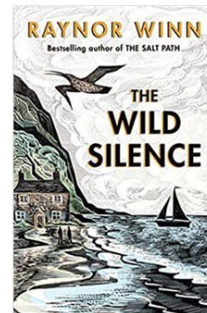
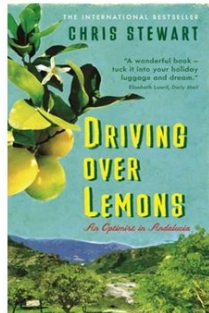
