**Please turn over for exam procedures and guidelines**

**Report 10 minutes before the exam start time.**

**Do not attend morning registration when you have a 9am exam.**

**Put bags and coats under one of the canopy areas.**

**Equipment needed for exam in a clear plastic case: 2 pens with black ink, 2 pencils, eraser, ruler, protractor, compasses, calculator (remove cover).**

**Any notes/working out – make in exam paper and then cross out.**

**No Mobile phones, MP3 players or data storage devices near the exam hall.**

**No watches to be worn.**

**Line up outside entrance to sports hall like you do for PE.**

**Line up in groups, quietly, alphabetically and in your teaching group.**

**Full school uniform, no coats or jumpers other than the school sweatshirt.**

**Enter sports hall sensibly and in silence from the back, do not cut across the rows.**

**Your behaviour should be exemplary, no talking or signaling to people.**

**Any instructions that you are unsure about or don't hear clearly put your hand up.**

**If you finish the exam early, check your work carefully.**

**At end of exam you will be dismissed row by row and we require silence.**

**Desks will be checked before and after each exam for graffiti.**

**Use your year group toilets before lining up for your exam.**

**If you feel unwell let invigilators know and they will contact a member of staff.**

**Check where exam is, most are in the sports hall, but not all.**
