100%	Nothing lost, everything gained.	Every chance of outstanding success
97%	Up to 6 days, 30 lessons	Good chance of success.
95%	Up to 9.5 days, 45 lessons	Below expectation, catch up required.
92%	Up to 15 days, 75 lessons,	Below expectations. Falling behind impacting upon academic success. You could drop 1 grade.
90%	19 days of absence, 85 lessons	Seriously below expectations.
Below 90%	More than 19 days of absence. Over 110 lessons.	Critical Persistent Absence




