Attendance Percentage	Lost learning	Academic outcome
100%	<i>Nothing lost, everything gained.</i>	<i>Every chance of outstanding success</i>
97%	<i>Up to 6 days, 30 lessons</i>	Good chance of success.
95%	<i>Up to 9.5 days, 45 lessons</i>	Below expectation, catch up required.
92%	<i>Up to 15 days, 75 lessons,</i>	Below expectations. Falling behind impacting upon academic success. You could drop 1 grade.
90%	<i>19 days of absence, 85 lessons</i>	Seriously below expectations.
Below 90%	More than 19 days of absence. Over 110 lessons.	Critical Persistent Absence

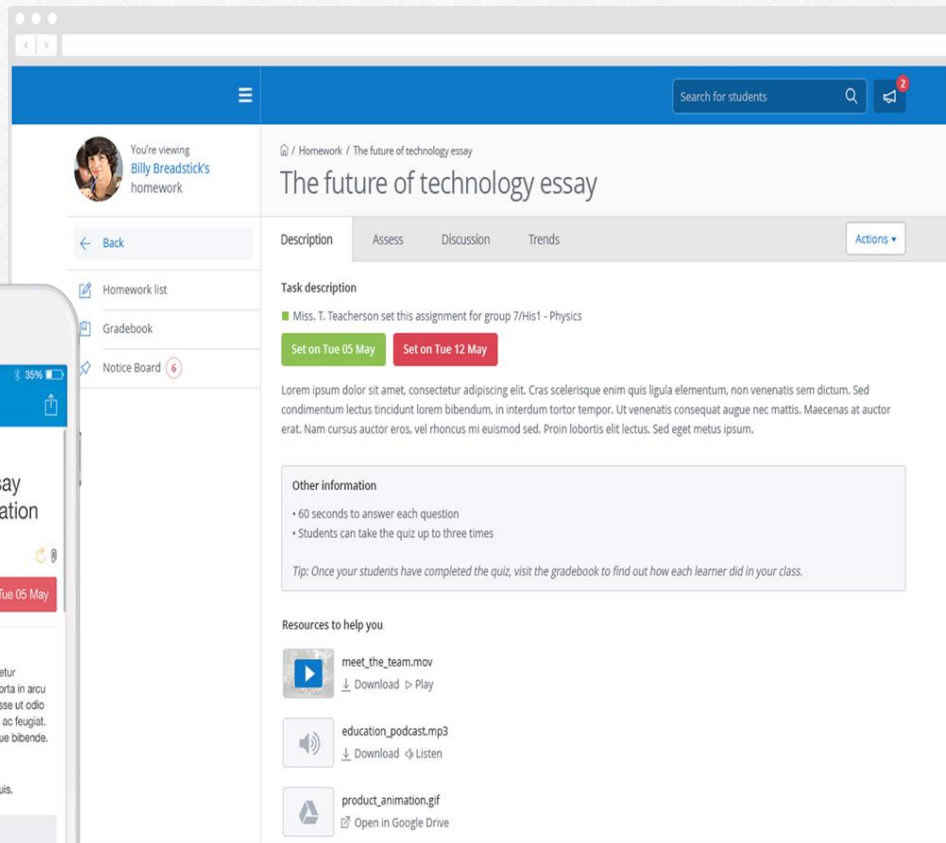

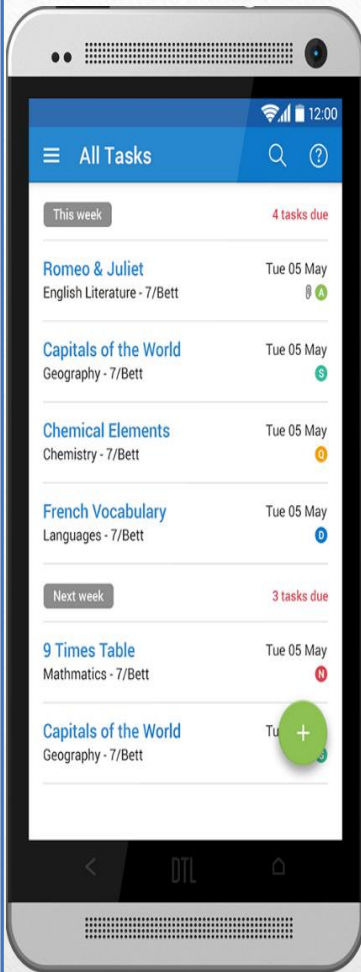
